On show day the group posted average EPDs of BW 3.4; WW 58; YW 95; MM 26; M&G 54; FAT 0.0; REA .40; MARB .06. The group had an average scrotal measurement of 35.0 cm.



Reserve Champion Carload — Jensen Bros., Courtland, KS

The group of spring bull calves was sired by KCF Bennett Influence Z80, CRR 719 Catapult 109, H Dimaggio 2094 ET, UPS Domino 3027, SHF Wonder M326 W18 ET and BR DM TNT 7010 ET. The average weight of the load was 1,140 lbs. and they calculated a WDA of 3.75 lbs. The average EPDs of the group were BW 2.7; WW 62; YW 101; MM 29; M&G 59; FAT 0.0; REA 0.59; and MARB 0.16. They had an average scrotal measurement of 34.7 cm.







Byron's Editorial...

John loved the western United States and had spent some years here with his parents. John also like purebred Hereford cattle and in the early 1970's bought a beautiful ranch near Salmon, Idaho called Pine Creek Hereford Ranch. Pine Creek had a great Hereford history, mostly built around Evan Mischief bred cattle that originated from the Deschmaeker cattle in Montana and some Herb Chandler bred cattle from Oregon. These cattle were very sizable cattle which at the time were very much in demand because of the size, performance and pedigrees that were known as "clean". I first met John at one of their production sales at the Salmon ranch and had a very nice visit with him. John looked more like a Hollywood star than a man selling Hereford cattle, as he was about 6'4" tall, very thin, suave and very handsome. It was very interesting because the clientele at Pine Creek were basically tough old ranchers that had known only hard work and tough times, and a few purebred people that came into buy some of the Mischief bred cattle for their herds. I heard a lot of people in the crowd before the sale wondering who this DeLorean was, and they acted pretty negatively to this big, rich guy coming in to sell bulls.

When the sale started and the auctioneer announced that John DeLorean would like to speak to them a little before the sale, there was a little pause be-

cause John was not up on the block with the auctioneer but was out in the sale ring and moved among the crowd and talked about how he loved this country, the cattle and the people in this country. John Wayne could not have done a better job captivating the crowd than DeLorean did and the buzz throughout the sale barn was extremely positive and went on for several minutes and even made it difficult for the auctioneer to get the crowd's attention again and begin the sale.

I was elected President of the American Hereford Association the next year. and about a month before the annual Pine Creek bull sale, I received a call from John DeLorean congratulating me on my election and then asking if I would be attending his bull sale. I told John that it was my plan to attend the sale and that I would be flying my own airplane from home over to the Salmon airport, and arriving about ten o'clock in the morning. John said he was happy to hear that I was coming, and that and he would have a car at the Salmon airport waiting for our arrival, and we could have use of the car to get to the sale and then we could return to the airport at our convenience.

At that time the Salmon airport was a somewhat quiet rural airport located about five miles south of town. We landed at Salmon right on time and as I taxied up to the tie down area I noticed a beautiful bright red Pontiac Firebird sitting beside the small pilot house at the airport. As we were getting out of the airplane a fellow came out of the shack

and asked if I was Byron, I replied I was, and he told me this Firebird was left here for you by John DeLorean and here are the keys. During the year that I was president of the AHA no one but John DeLorean left me a bright red Pontiac Firebird to use for the day. I really hated to give it back! The sale again was great and John again captivated the crowd with his unbelievable people handling skills. That great day was the last time that I ever saw John.

John was the son of a Romanian immigrant and his mother was an immigrant from Austria/Hungary. John was born in 1925 in Detroit, Michigan. John went to grade school and high school in Detroit, where he was an honor student. He received a scholarship from Lawrence Technical Institute that produced some of the industry's great engineers. He then went on to the military and served the country well in that phase of his life. John started working for Chrysler Corporation and did other things including Life Insurance sales, until he went to work full time at Chrysler.

After Chrysler John went to Packard Motor Company where his capabilities were very duly noticed by General Motors, and they offered him his choice of jobs in one of five divisions of General Motors. His history was duly noticed by General Motors by the cars previously mentioned that he designed. He rose to the rank of vice president with General Motors and his eventual rise to president seemed inevitable, but the political presence of the General Motors hierarchy passed him over. So he left General Mo-

tors and in 1973 formed his own company, The DeLorean Motor Company, where he designed a unique sports car that distinctively used stainless steel, gull wing doors and a high performance V-6 engine developed by European manufacturers. The new plant was built in Northern Ireland. By 1982 more than half of the roughly 7000 DMC-12 cars that had been produced remained unsold, the company was in debt to the tune of \$175 million and the factory was placed into receivership. The very sad part of the story is that in 1982 De-Lorean was charged with trafficking by the US government. He was absolved of all of the charges but with these charges against him and financial problems in his company his future was clearly clouded. The Idaho ranch, the cattle and the great Hereford herd he had built with it were haphazardly dispersed. He tried to resurrect his car company and made plans for a raised monorail transport that was never built. For the next 10 years things went poorly for DeLorean and he had to declare bankruptcy and after fighting over 40 court cases he was forced to sell his 434 acre estate in New Jersey. It was purchased by a real estate tycoon DONALD TRUMP and converted to a golf course. John DeLorean died from a stroke in 2005 at age 80, he was interred in Troy, Michigan, with military honors for his service to our country in World War Two.

And now I have told you part of "the rest of the story", to be continued next month

The Yards and Livestock Exchange Building are well over 100 years old and showing their age but are a rich part of the Denver tradition. The National Western has plans to update, upgrade and replace many of the facilities. It will be called the National Western Center. The Center will encompass the existing grounds plus several of the surrounding neighborhoods and will take over a decade to complete. Cost estimates are \$856.4 million.

The livestock industry lost a great man on December 31 with the passing of Pat Goggins, Billings, MT. The man was legendary in the cattle business and helped bring the Angus breed to the forefront. He was the auctioneer for many years at our ranch and I grew up hearing that wonderful voice and sale chant which later was closely replicated by his son, Joe.







Uruguay family deeply rooted in Herefords

By B. Lynn Gordon

Keeping farms within families for generation after generation is not only very important to American farm families, but was clearly evident with the Fernández family of Uruguay, which I had the opportunity to meet and view their Polled Hereford herd on a recent visit to Uruguay. For the past 35 years the family has developed a quality herd of Polled Herefords in a country known as the "Land of Herefords."

The senior generation Luis Fernández, his brother Hugo and their wives Andrea and Daniela Abella, own Sociedad Ganadera San Salvador Ltda., in southwestern Uruguay. They started breeding Polled Herefords in 1978, following in their father's footsteps. Today the third generation consists of six children, all whom have a connection to the farm because the pride to keep agricultural land within one family is as important in South America as it is here in the

U.S. Their ranch mission statement, 'to continue along the same path, expecting that future generations exceed current one, working with passion and proud Hereford breed,' confirms this goal.

Son Rodrigo, is responsible for the daily management and oversight of the Polled Hereford operation however, his father Luis and brother Santiago work closely with him when it comes to selection of genetics and overall management. All registration records and paperwork is conducted by Andrea.

American genetic influence

When San Salvador Ranch was looking to expand their genetic pool, they looked to the U.S. In 1986, they imported 12 heifers from the well-known Wooden Shoe Farms. The cattle arrived by airplane along with frozen embryos purchased. San Salvador was the first ranch to implant frozen embryos in Uruguay and started an aggressive embryo transfer program which had a major impact on Uruguay's Polled Hereford genetics. Currently, they collect 250 embryos annually and manage 110 pedigreed dams. Within the past three years they also placed 180 embryos and sold 12 heifers into Brazil and exported bulls and females to Argentina.

The ranch continues to closely monitor the U.S genetics and has infused genetics into their breeding program. I was able to view cattle sired by U.S. bulls such as TH 22R 16S Lambeau 17Y; KJ HVH 33N Redeem 485T; STAR KKH SSF Kamikaze; SHF Wonder M326 W18; and Boyd Worldwide 9050.

Marketing plan for future

Being in the southern hemisphere, calving occurs September thru November (their spring) and what we call fall calving. Their weaning percentage is impressive at 90%. As their program grew the family decided to offer their genetics beyond private treaty sales and sales at exhibitions. In October 2015, they hosted their 16th annual auction selling 65 bulls and 35 bred heifers at Tacuarembo (located in central Uruguay).

"One of our main goals for the bulls is to have herd average EPDs above the Pan American average (breed average for Uruguay), but not extreme, we want the cattle to work for their buyers



providing meat volume, pigment and phenotype," Luis says. Their 2015 bulls averaged \$4,600 (U.S. dollars), comparing this to an average of \$3,000 for the total of 6,000 Hereford bulls sold into commercial markets in Uruguay, demonstrating the quality and demand for the San Salvador program. Bulls going into registered herds sell from \$8,000 to \$10,000. The bulls are sold as two-year-olds or two-and-half years old. "In Uruguay, commercial producers will not buy yearling bulls, they want more mature bulls that are fully developed, which is different than the U.S," Santiago says. He explained, most bulls are put out with the cows and not regularly checked because of the size of pasture and the landscape, and thus the owner is more confident in buying an older bull.

Our goal is to aim for cattle that end with a frame between 5 and 6. The ranch is trying a new experiment with their heifer program. Typically in Uruguay, a heifer is bred between 18 and 22 months. However, San Salvador wanted to experiment with selecting low birth-weight sires and move up the breeding age of their heifers to 15 months of age. As a result these heifers will be 7-8 months pregnant at October sale time and the buyer will receive a calf in a month, rather than wait 4 months for the calf. We will just have to see how it works, Luis and Santiago stated.



Show winning program

Uruguay's equivalent to the National Western Stock Show is Expo Prado. In the family's very first debut at Expo Prado in 1983, they won Reserve Grand Champion Female. From that day, their list champions has grown to be overwhelming. Yet, one award that proudly is displayed in their ranch home is a special award from the US Embassy. This award is given to the first ranch to win five Supreme Champion Bulls at the Expo Prado's Show. The San Salvador Ranch is the first and only ranch to date to win this award, winning Supreme Champion Bull in 1998, 2006, 2008, 2009 and 2012. The ranch has also won the Supreme Champion in 1991 (before the award was in place) and 2013 (after they already reached the milestone.)

For those who have the opportunity to visit the Sociedad Ganadera San Salvador Ltda, and meet the Fernández family during the World Hereford Conference, Post Tour (B) on April 25 — you are in for a treat. You will have a fantastic tour of Polled Herefords, a tasty Uruguayan Asado beef meal and be greeted by a wonderful family with a true love for Polled Herefords.

Editor's Note: Lynn Gordon, SDSU Ag Leadership Specialist/Assistant Professor at South Dakota State University, took a group of 11 SDSU students on a study-tour of Argentina and Uruguay, Dec. 28-Jan. 8. This is one of several ranches they visited on their trip.

This course/trip is one of five of the international travel study trips offered by SDSU's College of Agriculture and Biological Sciences. Other tour sites visited during the 12-day study trip include visits to: the Port of Rosario - Argentina's largest grain exporting port; the U.S. Embassy based in Buenos Aires which oversees agriculture in Argentina, Uruguay and Paraguay; the world's largest livestock auction market; the board of trade; and in both countries (Argentina and Uruguay) several on-site visits to crop and livestock farms to visit directly with the producers about production parameters and learn about the similarities and differences between U.S. and South American production practices. Another visit will be to the headquarters of CHS, Inc., special supporters for this year's student travel group. Plus visits to cultural and historical sites to round out the overall experience.

South Dakota Ranchers File Suit Over 2013 Blaze

After a U.S. Forest Service-ignited fire sickened and killed cattle while burning privately-owned grass, fences, hay and trees, and the agency refused to compensate them, Perkins County, South Dakota ranchers have now taken the next step and filed suit.

Rancher and forest service permittee Vince Gunn, Shadehill, SD said that civil action - which would result in a jury trial – is not permissible when suing the federal government. "You'd be guaranteed of getting somewhere with that, it would hasten the process," he said. Instead, he and other ranchers filed three separate tort claims - their only option – in U.S. District Court in Rapid City, SD. The U.S. Department of Agriculture informed the ranchers in June of 2015 that it would accept no responsibility and cover no associated expenses from the April 2013 fire.

Gunn said three different attorneys offered their services to the ranchers who suffered loss in the so-called Pautre Fire. The U.S. Forest Service chose to light a prescribed burn on federal land on a warm, windy day following months of drought. The fire burned beyond the planned 135 acres of crested wheatgrass on the west side of the Grand River National Grasslands, to

encompass estimated 11,000 acres – about two-thirds private and onethird federal land. The properties are intermingled and include a number of shared fences.

Gunn said he and a few others chose to hire a Rapid City attorney from the Bangs McCullen law firm.

While he did endure mental and physical stress during and after the fire, Gunn said the only damages seeking he's for are actual.

documentable damages, like fencing materials, labor and loss of value to his property. Gunn has received no compensation for any losses from the fire, and he is not aware of any other ranchers nor the grazing association being offered any reimbursement.




compensation The Pautre Fire burned approximately 11,000 acres of prime grazing land on private and federal land.

There was one point in the midst of the fire that Gunn became surrounded by flames and was able to walk through them to safety, probably due to the coveralls he was wearing, he said. He did not have cattle on the land that burned, so there were no ill-affects to

his livestock.

Gunn explained that a leasee cannot sue for damages on leased property. Some absentee landowners have filed suit, and the grazing association itself has joined a lawsuit separate from

Gunn's, seeking compensation for expense to rebuild fence and for damages on land the association owns.

President of the Grand River Grazing Association, Dan Anderson of Meadow, SD, confirmed that the association is a party in a lawsuit but chose not to confirm the name of the attorney and said he doesn't know the exact dollar amount sought but confirmed that the majority of the association's expense was and continues to be fence rebuilding. Former Grand River Grazing Association president Tim Smith, Lodgepole, SD, commented in an earlier TSLN story that around 25 miles of association fence burned and tort claim specialist Frank Carroll had helped at least one rancher settle on a value of \$4 per foot for rebuilding fence, based on local fencing crew estimates.

In order to gain ground in the lawsuit, the plaintiffs have to prove complete negligence on the part of the U.S. Forest Service.

In an earlier *TSLN* story, Smith, recalled then-USFS ranger Paul Hancock saying at a public meeting in Hettinger, ND, about five days following the fire, "The Forest Service is liable and responsible. We will do whatever it takes to make you whole again." Those same

words appeared on a poster in the room the day of the meeting.

Smith also said in that story that the Bismarck weather department had reported extreme dry conditions and recommended no burning. Local ranchers also asked the Forest Service not to burn because the area was very dry after months of drought and they day was expected to be warm and very windy.

Gunn credited the numerous local fire departments that hurried to the fire, for eventually extinguishing it.

According to the *Rapid City Journal*, three lawsuits were filed.

One suit lists five rancher and farmer plaintiffs in Perkins County: the Darci D. Feifer Limited Partnership; David and Lori Bossman, general partners (listed as one plaintiff); Vincent and Susan Gunn (listed as one plaintiff); Duane Meink; and Ken Krisle. They are represented by Terry Hofer, of the Bangs McCullen Law Firm in Rapid City.

The second complaint includes nine plaintiffs: Eric and Laurie Casper (listed as two plaintiffs), Diamond Acres Trust, Grand River Cooperative Grazing Association, Robert and Connie Hermann (listed as two plaintiffs), Ryan Hermann, Jamie Hermann and Roger Sonn. They are represented by Gary Jensen of the Beardsley, Jensen


