next month but CHB seems to be in the forefront of my mind as I write this.

I had the pleasure of attending the North Dakota All Breeds Tour last month. It was held in the Dickinson area which isn't very far from us plus there were several Hereford breeders on the tour. The breed was very well represented with Hereford stops at Strohs near Killdeer, NE; Peltons near Halliday, ND; Friedts near Mott, ND; and a display by Zach and Larissa Tessier at Belfield. Certified Hereford Beef program changes marbling specifications

KANSAS CITY, MO — The Certified Hereford Beef® and the American Hereford Association (AHA) Board of Directors voted unanimously to modify the minimum marbling score requirement of the current Schedule G-10 for the Certified Hereford Beef brand.

The minimum marbling score requirement will be modified from a Slight00 marbling score to a Small00 marbling score to elevate the quality level of the Certified Hereford $\operatorname{Beef}^{\circledR}$ brand to a USDA Choice quality grade.

"Our Hereford farmers and ranchers have worked diligently over the years to improve the Hereford breed," says Amari Seiferman, Certified Hereford Beef® chief operating officer. "This modification is a testament to that work and proves Certified Hereford Beef® is a premium quality product. We are proud to move our brand forward into a new era of success."

The marbling score modification will go into effect on Jan. 1, 2019. The Certified Hereford Beef brand will serve cus-(continued on page 6)







If you Google G10 Certified Hereford Beef, you will find quite a bit of information on it, including previous G10 specs.

The latest change addresses marbling. "The minimum marbling score requirement will be modified from a Slight00 marbling score to a Small00 marbling score to elevate the quality level of the Certified Hereford Beef brand to a USDA Choice quality grade," says the press release.

I find this interesting, after founding the program on a leaner Hereford beef product that tastes like Choice. It is hard to fight the perception that Choice is better.

One thing I learned while on the beef packing company board I was on, the business of selling meat is very cutthroat and price drives a great deal of the business. Flavor and tenderness are huge factors in the end and are drivers in another sector of the business which focuses on a more high-end product which, I assume, is what they are trying to attain. I think there is room in the market for both.

CHB is an incredible product and Hereford beef is hard to beat, whether it is Select or Choice or Prime. It will be interesting to see where the program goes with their new specs and I am anxious to hear what their plans are for the future.

At the upcoming American Hereford Association annual meeting there is a session devoted to CHB program changes. I'm sure it will be an interesting discussion.



farm and raise Angus and Charolais cattle and Jenna has filtered Herefords into the mix now as well. They have three children, Logan (15), Mabry (12) and Max (7). "We enjoy working together as a family on the cattle, attending shows or participating in 4-H or FFA events," she said. "We look forward to going as a family to the 2019 Junior National Hereford Expo."

Growth of Midwest Classic

"My sister and I started the Midwest Classic in 2007 because Minnesota no longer had a summer junior show and it was something when we were younger, we enjoyed participating in,"

says Jenna. "The first year we had 35 head from Minnesota and South Dakota, hosting the event in late July after Junior Nationals. But we found late July to conflict with so many county fairs."

When the Red River Valley Fair in Fargo, ND, held in June, moved to new dates in July, the sisters quickly rescheduled their event to the now available June weekend. The move turned out to be very beneficial and the event took off. By 2013, the Midwest Classic hit a record 165 Hereford entries. It now averages around 130 head, depending on time and location of the national junior show. In addition to Minnesota and South Dakota, juniors have traveled from North Dakota, Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas,

"The local county commissioners have been great," said Jenna, "they are visionary and supportive of our event and the need to continually make improvements to the fairgrounds." Within the last 10 years a new show arena, wash racks, and tie-outs were added, and a new stalling barn was built for the 2017 show. The

MN Junior Hereford Association board members assist with fundraising, and the event has built strong followership and financial support from donors. The 2019 Midwest Classic is June 21-23.

Career comes full circle

This led to her educational path, double majoring in animal science and food science with a minor in food safety from NDSU. She also judged meats at the college level, worked at the University meat lab and did an internship with Cargill. Jenna worked five years in the turkey industry for Northern Pride before moving back to her home area to work in the meat snack industry for a local company prior to joining J&B in 2016.

"I thoroughly enjoy my job working in the raw meat industry. No day is the same. It is full of variety, a lot like farming and raising cattle." Her duties involve working with USDA to ensure compliance standards, auditing the plant from food safety and quality perspective, visiting customers, writing policy and procedures, problemsolving, developing and implementing new products and managing her team.

The J&B Group primarily produces ground beef, portioned steaks, chops and chicken for retail and foodservice accounts in addition to their transportation and warehousing business units across their two locations, Pipestone and St. Michael, MN.

At her home-based facility, the focus is primarily on the production of ground beef products and portioned steaks, including the utilization of CHB in their product line. CHB ground beef is shipped in from Greater Omaha and packaged as part of the company's new Seal Fresh Program. Seal Fresh means nothing is added to the package, the product is in a

non-modified atmosphere, and the lack of oxygen increases the shelf-life of the raw product. Ground beef packaged through the Seal Fresh Program has a 25-day shelf life. "This new technology is great, to be able to take the shelf-life of a raw product out that many days, really has expanded what we can do at the retail level." The CHB Fresh Seal products primarily sold through Coborn's grocery stores, a chain in the upper Midwest, however, J&B does market the product through other customers as well.

Connecting Meats to Beef Production

From her work in food safety, Jenna can share back with others on the production side of the beef industry the importance of keeping cattle appropriately bedded, especially in feedlots. "Keeping hides clean is extremely important in keeping microbial loads down at the slaughter plants and in turn results in a much safer product for the end consumer.'

"My job gives me the opportunity to share what happens behind the walls of a processing plant – the technology used to produce safe and high-quality products, how value is added to products cattle producers produce and tell the story from farm to plate. The reverse is true as well, my background of growing up and still actively being a part of our cattle and grain operation gives me a wealth of experience I'm able to share with coworkers, customers, and consumers who don't have as deep of an understanding of the beef production industry."


Wilford Seim


To Bruce Everheart for the old 1904 and 1905 Hereford Herd Record Books.

He says his grandfather Harry O'Neal homesteaded in 1888 along with his brother Fank and father John O'Neal along the Miner County and Sanborn County lines SW of Fedora, SD.

They were Scots-Irish who settled first in Pennsylvania, moved to Iowa and with word of free land came to South Dakota.

At one time Harry had 6 quarters of land but lost all but one during the Depression years. His banker in Artesian, SD, told him he would loan money to him to save one quarter. He leased the land to Ferdinand Schwader of Howard, SD until he could rebuild his own herd of Hereford cattle again.

Bruce's mother had a clipping of Harry topping the market in Chicago, IL. Cattle then were shipped by rail because there were no packing plants in the area at that time.







Final Farewell...

Carl W Kucera

Carl W. Kucera, 90, of Litchfield, NE, passed away at Rose Lane Nursing Home in Loup City on Saturday, Sept. 1, 2018.

Carl Wayne Kucera was born at home Dec. 21, 1927, near Davis Creek in the North Loup Township to Frank H. and (Millie) Johanna Maria Amelia (Neumann) Kucera. In 1936, they moved to a farm north of Hazard where he had his first horse. He attended Pleasant Hill country school and graduated from Litchfield High School in 1945. Carl and his brother, George, rode their horses to attend high school.

In the spring of 1946, Carl joined the United States Army and served as a paratrooper for the Army of Occupation, 11th Airborne, in Japan. He returned home the summer of 1947 to continue his life in farming, working for Irwin Urwiller of Ravenna, NE. He was experienced with handling horsedrawn equipment to do farming until he purchased his first Minneapolis Moline tractor.

On May 23, 1951, he married his high school sweetheart, Grace Kuhn, at the family farm of Clyde and May Kuhn, north of Litchfield. Carl worked for Klein Elevator in Ravenna. During their married life they resided on farms south of Sweetwater and south of Hazard until purchasing the farm north of

Hazard, which eventually included the farm where Carl spent his youth and teen years.

Carl and Grace resided on this farm for 55 years. They celebrated their 65th anniversary at the family farm in 2016. They had seven children, 19 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren.

Through his life Carl farmed, milked cows and raised registered Polled Hereford cattle with his son, Frank. Carl enjoyed farming every day and believed it was the best life for raising a family. Carl also served as rural mail carrier for the Hazard and Sweetwater post offices before finishing his 13-year career for the Cairo post office.

Carl had an active public service interest in his life. He served on the Hazard school board and was instrumental in the construction of the new elementary school in 1960. As a youth, Carl rode his horse to Hazard to attend Confirmation classes at the Hazard Lutheran Church parsonage with the Rev. O.J. Lundly. Carl was confirmed along with his brother George in 1945. Carl was a lifelong member of Faith Lutheran Church and served on the church council, was the Sunday school superintendent, a Sunday school teacher and confirmation instructor during the years his children were in attendance. Carl's church membership was an ongoing blessing throughout his life.

Carl was elected to the Sherman County Board of Supervisors in 1982. He led the change from a seven-member board of supervisors to a three-member commissioners' board. Carl served 14 years, 10 of those as board chairman, and was the representative for Region 26 Emergency Services. He enjoyed the challenges and projects while working with other public officials and appreciated visiting with the people of Sherman County and state officials of Nebraska.

Carl found joy in everyday experiences. He always found time throughout his busy life to help a neighbor, lend a helping hand to all family members and be present at the activities and events of his children and grandchildren. Celebrating family was the constant. Family get-togethers for every holiday and birthday kept everyone connected.

In the early years, Carl enjoyed riding his favorite horse at the time to check cattle. Later it was a pickup ride to the pastures on a summer evening to put out salt. Always he could be heard whistling on a "Minnie" tractor heading out to the fields to farm.
